This is why, as a business, we are looking to create a new standard for sustainable development at ExCeL in Phase 3. We are aiming to achieve this by:

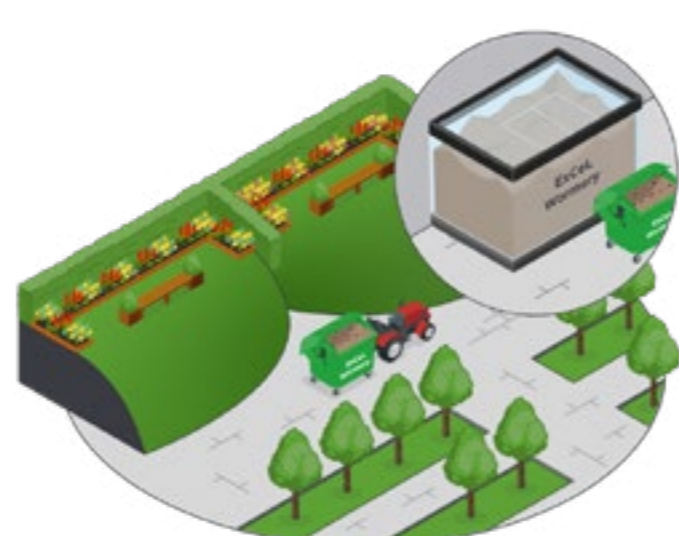
- ✓ Targeting a BREEAM rating of 'Excellent'

- ✓ Providing 2,000m<sup>2</sup> of rooftop photovoltaic panels, to promote renewable energy across the site
- ✓ Creating a biodiversity net gain across the site
- ✓ Increasing the number of cycles parking spaces
- ✓ Committing to delivering a car-free expansion
- ✓ Encouraging people to travel to ExCeL by public transport, especially via the two DLR stations (Custom House and Prince Regent) as well as the Elizabeth line which will be running when Phase 3 opens in 2024
